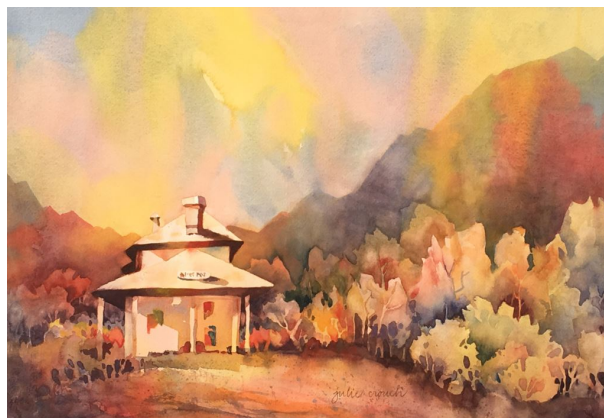

**“SHAPES! VALUE! COLOR! . . .
AN ORGANIZING APPROACH TO PAINTING IN WATERCOLOR”**

Have you ever approached a clean white piece of watercolor paper, wondering “Where should I begin?” After years of classes and workshops, Julie realized that she needed a way to synthesize the information her instructors had so generously imparted so that her brain wasn’t bombarding her with all of the disparate bits as she painted. In this one-day workshop, Julie Crouch will share how she simplifies her thought process in order to paint stronger watercolors by:

- Simplifying your subject to 4 values
- Simplifying your subject by shapes of value (rather than by object) to make the pictorial space read well
- Learning to think in terms of layers
- Simplifying your color palette for harmony
- Working from large shapes to small
- Working from light values to dark
- Working from general to specific
- Take advantage of soft edges to make your hard edges really count
- Learning to recognize when to stop

This will be a fun and exciting one-day workshop....
