ARTIST NEWS

MVAL was well represented at the annual **Hillcrest Festival of the Arts in La Habra Heights** February 25-27.

Thirty-two artists, most of them entering three paintings, competed in the Watercolor category.

Placing first in Watercolor was **Hanna Adler**. **Tom Fong** placed third. Honorable Mentions went to **Donna Larson**, **Jan Wright** and **Nancy Shiershke**. Nancy also won an Honorable Mention in the Acrylic/Oil/Pastel category. In the Graphics/Mixed Media category, **Michi Ikeda** and **Setsuko Okubo** received Honorable Mentions as well. With over 450 entries across the eight categories, the competition was strong.

Perhaps, the best award, however, is having someone else take one's painting home. That honor went to **Shirley Manning** for the sale of her "Trees" watercolor.

This year 130 artists presented their work during the festival which features performance art as well as fine crafts. Participation requires being juried into the festival by a panel of judges. Tom Fong was the featured artist presenting a solo show several years ago.

MVAL - ON-GOING SHOW **to be held at Camilo's Restaurant, Eagle Rock**

MVAL has an opportunity to have an on-going show at **Camilo's** Restaurant in Eagle Rock.

The first show is targeted for around February 1st and each show will hang for 2 months.

The restaurant has space for 11 pieces of art. There are 9 spaces that can hang art measuring a maximum of 28" x 36" with a minimum of 18" x 24". There is one space suitable for a vertical painting measuring 16" x 20" and a smaller space that can handle an 18" x 25" piece.

If you are interested in hanging artwork at Camilo's you are encouraged to bring art to the monthly meeting (following the size requirements. Art should be framed with plexiglass when appropriate. Unframed, stretched canvases may also be hung.

Each painting must have the name and price of the painting and an email address. This information will be displayed with the painting. Restaurant patrons who may wish to

purchase a painting will communicate directly with the artist.

Nether Camilo's nor MVAL will take a percentage or be involved in anyway with the sale of the art.

Art that is sold must stay on display until the show's completion. It will be the artist's responsibility to communicate with the buyer concerning getting their painting.

If there are more paintings submitted than there is space for, a committee of board members will select the paintings to go into the first show.

This is a new endeavor and there are still a few details that are being worked on, but it is a wonderful opportunity for MVAL members to get their artwork seen, perhaps sold and for people to become familiar with our organization.
