

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

This is the month MVAL and I share our 56th birthday. I'm not sure about me, but I think MVAL has gotten better with age.

Earlier this year a goal was set to have MVAL members become involved in coming up with ideas and suggestions on how to keep MVAL a dynamic and growing organization. A Strategic Visioning Committee was formed to review our past and determine how MVAL should proceed in the future. A survey was developed and handed out at the May General meeting. 44 members responded that evening and 4 more surveys have been received to-date! There were ten questions related to reducing expenses and ten questions looking for ways to increase income. The results of the survey have already been used to create a preliminary budget for 2010. Several ideas and suggestions are planned to be implemented at the beginning of next year. And other suggestions will be evaluated further.

Even prior to the survey new ideas regarding exhibitions and special events were happening. For instance, MVAL members will have the opportunity to exhibit at the Arcadia Library in November and December in the first MVAL Miniature Show. And coming up this summer in August, MVAL members have an opportunity to contribute to The Wellness Community, a very worthy organization. This will be a unique event allowing members to exhibit donated paintings at Madeline's Restaurant in Pasadena. A reception and a dinner will be available for artists and patrons to take part in. Hopefully this will be the start of a long relationship between MVAL and The Wellness Community.

June isn't going out with a whimper. Wednesday 10, is our next Visioning Committee meeting. Wednesday 17, is the general meeting with the end of the year raffle. And Wednesday 24, is the Annual MVAL Banquet. July won't be totally left out, Wednesday 8, will be the second MVAL Crit Night, all are welcome to participate.

The first year as President has gone by quickly. A big THANK YOU to the MVAL Board for all the time and effort that they have invested. It is much appreciated!

Ernie Marjoram is a professional artist working in the design industry. He creates concept art for architecture, interiors, film & TV, video games and theme park environments.

While developing virtual reality attractions for Walt Disney Imagineering, Ernie met many artists such as Dan Goozee' and Steve Huston who first introduced him to the California Art Club and encouraged him to consider fine art.

Ernie is a Painting Patron member of the CAC and is actively involved with the Painting Patrons juried show. He travels to Europe regularly with his Italian wife Silvia and has painted on location in both Europe and Asia. They enjoy collecting art and own several original works by CAC artists.

Ernie also teaches design and drawing skills to production designers in the Masters of Fine Arts program at the American Film Institute. To

showcase the students artwork, he established an annual exhibit and a virtual art gallery on the AFI website. He has recently begun teaching public classes and workshops and plans to take a painting group to Scandinavia in 2008.

During the 80's Ernie served the LA Chapter of the American Institute of Architects as Chairman of the Design Awards Committee. The committee published a catalog of the wining designs and held a public exhibit of all entries.

In the 90's Ernie was on the Craft & Folk Art Museum Board and helped to curate a contemporary furniture design exhibit.

Ernie & Silvia support several charitable organizations including the Assistance League, Hollywood Senior Multipurpose Center, Providence St. Josephs Children's Hospital and Inner City Arts. Silvia is Chairperson of the LA Chapter of Operation School Bell and serves on the Board of Inner City Arts.



2009-2010 MVAL BUDGET

On May 13 a combined Visioning/Finance Committee met to focus entirely on the financial status of MVAL, review of the proposed member survey and an analysis of issues regarding the 2009 budget. Following the distribution of the survey at the May 20 General Meeting, Alan Marriott, Jan Wright and Mark Wood met on May 26 to build a 2009 budget based on the committee work and the initial results of the member survey. The enclosed preliminary budget was agreed to at the June 3 Board meeting. It will be made available at the June 17th General meeting and reviewed with the membership at the September meeting.

SCHOLARSHIP NEWS

This year because of our budget crisis, our Scholarship Fund was reduced significantly from five thousand to two thousand dollars. In spite of this and the downturn in our economy, we were still able to award 3 (three) scholarships in the amount of \$300 to young artists from our community high schools and an \$800 scholarship to a Pasadena City College student. We gave an award of \$300.00 to the Art Department at Temple City High School which is in desperate need of art supplies and materials.

While not as generous as last year's awards., they still reflect the generous spirit of MVAL'S commitment to furthering the arts to the youth in our community...

The following students were this year's recipients:

David Chen, *Pasadena City College*. An excellent student working in both studio arts, (painting and drawing) and design. To date, he has a grade average of 4.00. David will continue in the visual arts and media studies program at PCC next semester.

Kathlaleen Cervantes, Sierra Vista High School, El Monte, Ca. She is an exceptional artist, who has completed four years of art and has applied to our state colleges to continue her art education . Her concentration will be painting Urban Landscapes.

Elizabeth Trujilla, Visual Arts & Design Academy, Pasadena High School. She is a dedicated art student who will be studying graphic design at PCC in the Fall of 2009.

Estela Castillo, Mountain View High School, El Monte, Ca. She is one of the school's best all around students. Two years ago, she produced an outstanding art portfolio and continues to reach higher levels in art each year. Her goal is to attend UC Santa Barbara.

Temple City High School, *Temple City*, Ca. Because of insufficient funds in the high school's art account, Mihee Kim, the art teacher, has had to buy much needed supplies on her own along with relying on parents for donations. Ms. Kim has always been grateful for our financial support and is very dedicated to her students.
