

111 S Grand Ave, Los Angeles, CA, between 1st & 2nd. Parking will cost, but you can take the Gold line to the Red line and get off at Civic Center. Walk to the left or south exit, out of the train station, it will get you there easily if you pack light. Bring a folding chair, lunch, and do plan on doing abstracts, in any medium you choose!!!!

JULY18TH, Newcomb's Ranch in Angeles Forest

Take the 210 west to La Canada, exit at Angeles Crest Hwy (Hwy 2). Turn right and head up the mountain.

Set your odometer, it's 27 miles on Hwy 2 north from the 210 fwy. Stay on the 2, Newcomb's Restaurant will be just past Chilao Campground. Look on your left for the neon "Open" sign. Park in the lot, plan on staying and eating in the restaurant. Parking anywhere else requires a Wilderness Pass. Beautiful woodsy scenery! You'll really feel like you left the city behind you! Good eats, share a meal, they're big! We will do the critique inside the restaurant.

Entrance to Rose Hills just past the baseball field on your left. Go to top for views of Los Angeles in the distance. Bring a folding chair and lunch. Meet at the top for lunch.

AUG. 22ND, EXPOSITION PARK, LOS ANGELES

Take the Pasadena Fwy. to the Harbor Fwy. south. Exit onto West Exposition Blvd. Make a U-turn at Watt Way. 900 Exposition Blvd, Los Angeles 90007.

Meet in the Rose Garden under the African fig trees. Parking available in surrounding lots. \$10. Bring lunch.

AUG. 29TH MESOAMERICAN GARDEN AT FOREST LAWN LOS ANGELES

Take the 210 fwy west to the 134 fwy west to Forest Lawn Dr. entrance on the left. meet at the top at the Hall of the Patriots, and the Mesoamerican Plaza. Bring lunch.

SEPT 5th LOS ANGELES ARBOURETUM, ARCADIA

301 N. Baldwin Ave. traveling east or west on the 210 Fwy take the Baldwin Ave exit and go south.

Arboretum is on west side of the street. There is a small entrance fee to gardens.
