THURSDAYS IN PLEIN AIR

To confirm or ask questions call Call Lynne Fearman (626) 355-7562 cell: (626) 487-6566
Bring lunch or take a chance there will be a place to buy.

Meet at the designated location at 9:00am and paint till 12:00.

At noon we gather for lunch and sharing of sketches and paintings. After lunch is the critique/share.

The critiques are informative and instructional. In the event of rain the paint-out will be canceled.

We have done our best to give accurate directions. Since we are based in San Gabriel, our directions stem from there.

It is each person's responsibility to carry a map, GPS, or double check directions.

If you are on Facebook, joint the "Thursdays in Plein Air" Facebook Page. The Facebook page will keep you updated on any changes and you can also connect with the other painters!

JUNE 9th - HOME OF MOLLY MUNGER & STEVE ENGLISH, PASADENA

(may have to be rescheduled) 450 S. San Rafael Ave. House is located on the west side of the arroyo and has an exquisite view over looking the lower arroyo, park outside on street. Bring a lunch.

JUNE 16th- CHINA TOWN

Hill Street Towntown LA Take the Gold Line to China Town Station, or park in nearby lots for \$10. Group lunch will be at the Golden City Cafe around the corner. \$7.

JUNE 23rd- E. WARD RANCH, SIERRA MADRE

273 E. Highland Ave. Go North on Baldwin, right on Highland. Bring lunch.

JUNE 30th - CRYSTAL COVE, LAGUNA

Check maps for directions. I prefer to take the 57 south to the 91 east south on the 55 to the 405 south exit Jamboree Rd. or MacArthur Blvd. depending on traffic. left at Pacific Coast Hwy look for signs after 2 miles. Bring lunch or buy lunch there. (1 hr 25min) Fee to park.

JULY 7th - SAM MALOOF STUDIO

5131 Carnelian St, Alta Loma, CA 91701 (909) 484-3465
Take the 210 Freeway East to exit 57 for Carnelian St. use left 2 lanes to turn onto Carnelian St. Bring lunch.

JULY 14th - LA RIVER

134 To the 5 freeway.5 South, exit Los Feliz , east on Los Feliz over bridge, first right Glenfeliz, right on Sunnynook, turn right on Legion Ave to park (Legion runs along river).No restrooms, but gas station marts on Los Feliz just beyond Glenfeliz.

JULY 21st - GAMBLE HOUSE, PASADENA

4 Westmoreland Place. Located near the corner of Orange Grove and Walnut. This is a masterpiece of architecture in the American Arts and Crafts movement. Built by Greene & Greene brothers. Bring lunch.

JULY 28th - OLVERA STREET, LOS ANGELES

Leave at 8:30 am on the Gold Line from the Sierra Madre Villa Station in Pasadena (Located at Halstead St. and Foot-hill). We'll take the Gold Line to Union Station. It is a short walk across the street to Olvera St. Eat there or bring a lunch.

AUGUST 4th - CRYSTAL COVE NORTH LAGUNA

8471 N Coast Hwy, Laguna Beach, CA 92651 Chart your own course for this location. Be sure to map out how to get there, if you have any questions call Crystal Cove at (949) 494-3539

AUGUST 11th - KING GILLETTE RANCH

26800 Mulholland Hwy, Calabasas, CA 91302
(818) 878-0866 ext. 228 . Take the 134 fwy to the 101 North, exit Las Vergines Rd (N1) turn left at Mulholland Hwy. entrance will be on the right.

AUGUST 18th - EXPOSITION PARK, LOS ANGELES

Take the Pasadena Fwy. to the Harbor Fwy. south. Exit onto West Exposition Blvd. Make a U-turn at Watt Way. 900 Exposition Blvd, Los Angeles 90007. Meet in the Rose Garden under the African fig trees. Parking available in surrounding lots. \$10. Bring lunch.

AUGUST 25th - LA ARBORETUM

301 N Baldwin Ave, Arcadia, CA 91007, (626) 821-3222.
Take the 210 freeway to Arcadia, exit at Baldwin south on the right hand side. Located across the street from Santa Anita Race Track. Meet for lunch at the Peacock Cafe, buy or bring lunch.

SEPTEMBER 1st - LIGHTHOUSE, LONG BEACH

Take the Long Beach Freeway south to Shoreline Drive. Parking around or behind the Aquarium. There is also a small parking area where fishermen park. You can see Shoreline Village from the Lighthouse and from the Aquarium.

Because of the distance involved with some of the locations on this schedule, I recommend an alternative location could be Eaton Canyon, Westfield Mall if it's too hot, or Monrovia Canyon Park. Check our Facebook page and ask others where they would like to paint. Carpooling is recommended for the long distant locations. Remember to pack a hat, sunscreen, umbrella, bug spray, and a tarp just in case!

If the weather is predicted to be very hot, try to arrive at 8 am instead of 9:00.

Chuck McPherson Workshop

September 22-24, 2016

In his eighth year as a watercolorist, Chuck's efforts have garnered hundreds of awards for his artwork. He holds triple Signature status with The San Diego Watercolor Society, National Watercolor Society and the Western Federation of Watercolor Societies.



He served as Member Shows Director on the SDWS Board, as Third VP on the NWS Board, plus a 3-year stint as Newsletter Chair on the Board of Directors for the San Diego Museum of Art Artists Guild.

He paints full-time and builds his reputation through a quick wit and his infamous 6" brush, flamboyantly creating paintings using props borrowed from large &

intimate crowds... like lipstick & coffee. A few years ago Chuck co-founded *BallastPointGallery.com* offering his fellow artists unique workshops and paint-alongs, and serves often as a discerning exhibition juror.
