He is popular workshop instructor and frequent juror. He has conducted workshops and seminars throughout the US, Mexico, Singapore and China.

Meet at the designated location at 9:00am and paint till 12:00. At noon we gather for lunch and sharing of sketches and paintings. After lunch is the critique/share. The critiques are informative and instructional. In the event of rain the paint-out will be canceled. We have done our best to give accurate directions. Since we are based in San Gabriel, our directions stem from there. It is each person's responsibility to carry a map, GPS, or double check directions.

SEPT. 5th - CHURCHES AND OLD GAS STATION, DUARTE

Huntington Dr. and Shamrock, go 1 block north on Shamrock. Church is on west side of street, next block large Catholic church on east side. An old gas station is located on the west side. You can also paint at County Park on right side, 1 block. Bring lunch.

SEPT. 12th - ARBORETUM, ARCADIA

301 N. Baldwin Ave. traveling east or west on the 210 Fwy take the Baldwin Ave exit and go south. Arboretum is on west side of the street. There is a small entrance fee to gardens. Paint anywhere. Meet at 12:15 at the Peacock Café it is the only place where food is allowed. Can bring or buy lunch.
