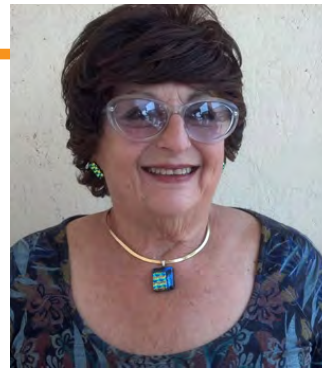
CAROLE BUSS

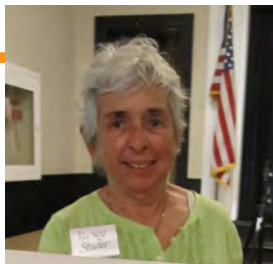
ART & THE ARTIST COVERS

Bring lunch or take a chance there will be a place to buy lunch.

Meet at the designated location at 9:00am and paint till 12:00. At noon we gather for lunch and sharing of sketches and paintings. After lunch is the critique/share. The critiques are informative and instructional. In the event of rain the paint-out will be canceled.

We have done our best to give accurate directions. Since we are based in San Gabriel, our directions stem from there. It is each person's responsibility to carry a map, GPS, or double check directions.

OCT. 10th - PASADENA PLAYHOUSE, PASADENA

39 S. El Molino Ave, Pasadena. ½ Block south of Colorado Blvd. Bring lunch.

OCT. 17th - OLVERA STREET, LOS ANGELES

Leave at 9:00 am on the Gold Line from the Sierra Madre Villa Station in Pasadena (Located at Halstead St. and Foothill). We'll take the Gold Line to Union Station. It is a short walk across the street to Olvera St. Eat there or bring a lunch.

OCT. 24th - MONROVIA LIBRARY PARK

321 S. Myrtle Ave, Monrovia, CA 91016. Take the 210 fwy to the Myrtle Ave. off ramp in Monrovia. Head north to Palm Ave. park on north side of the library. Bring lunch

OCT. 31st - OLD CHINA TOWN CENTRAL PLAZA

Take the Gold Line to China Town Station. Just up the street is a wonderful restaurant where we can eat family style for about \$7 each for ten of us. Plan on joining us for lunch there. Parking for \$3 off Broadway, next to plaza.

NOV. 7th - TOURNAMENT OF ROSES HOUSE

391 S. Orange Grove Blvd. Exit 134 fwy at Orange Grove and turn south. Historical building and rose gardens. You'll also find lots of interesting houses in the general area to paint too. Bring lunch

NOV. 14th - RANCHO LOS ENCINO

16756 Moorpark St., Encino Opens at 10am. No fee Restored 1840's ranch buildings and a small pond. Street parking only. Shaded picnic area. Restrooms and water on site. 101 Ventura Freeway to Balboa exit. Go south to Moorpark St.. (new fire station on the left) Turn left onto Moorpark. Rancho on right.

NOV. - 21th LA RIVER

134 To the 5 freeway. 5 South, exit Los Feliz, east on Los Feliz over bridge, first right Glenfeliz, right on Sunnynook, turn right on Legion Ave to park (Legion runs along river). No restrooms, but gas station marts on Los Feliz just beyond Glenfeliz.

NOV. 28th - DESCANSO GARDENS, LA CANADA

Take 210 Fwy to Angeles Crest exit in La Canada, turn left at end of ramp to Foothill Blvd, turn right to Verdugo Blvd, turn left to Descanso Drive, proceed to garden entrance on your right. There is an entrance fee. We will meet at the patio for lunch.

DEC. 5TH - COBB ESTATE, ALTADENA

Located at the top of Lake Ave. Drive all the way to the end of Lake, when it curves you will see a black rod iron gate on your right. No structures to paint but lots of trees, mountains and rough trails. Park on the street. Bring lunch. No restrooms.

DEC. 12TH - TRAVEL TOWN, GRIFFITH PARK

5200 Zoo Dr. Los Angeles. Go west on the 210 FWY. Continue on the 134 FWY to Forest Lawn Dr. exit, continue on to the Travel Town sign (new sign might say Griffith Park). Park opens at 10:00 am. Lots of old trains to see and paint. Near L.A. Zoo. Bring lunch or check out snack bar.

DEC. 19TH - BRENDA SWENSON'S HOUSE

514 El Centro Street, South Pasadena
Bring food for the pot luck lunch and paint in the quaint neighborhood with beautiful Victorian houses. Brenda has quite the antique truck collection too, and we will paint on our group project.

DEC. 26TH - MONROVIA CANYON PARK, MONROVIA

1200 N. Canyon Blvd. Take 210 to Myrtle, north to Foothill, turn right on Canyon Dr. go north bear right into park. There is a small entrance fee per car. Go all the way to the top or use lower parking area. Bring lunch.

JAN. 2ND - OLD MILL, SAN MARINO

1120 Old Mill Road, San Marion. From Huntington turn north on S. Oak Knoll Ave, at Old Mill turn right. Opens at 10 am. Oil painters must bring a tarp. Bring lunch.

JAN. 9TH -SANTA FE DAM RECREATION AREA , IRWINDALE

Irwindale 210 fwy. to Irwindale off ramp, then south to Gladstone, turn right (west) into park area. Coming from the south go East on Arrow Hwy. Look for sign on your left. Once inside, park in first parking lot. Entry fee. Bring lunch.
