





Chris Van Winkle is a California artist with roots in Canada. His art studies include Ontario College of Art, Toronto; Citrus College, Glendora, CA; and the Art Center College of Design, Los Angeles, California. He has studied extensively with Robert Hallett and with the legendary Milford Zornes. He has studied further with Robert E. Wood, Frank Webb, George James and Henry Fukuhara.



For the past 20 years Chris has been teaching watercolor at Citrus College. He has conducted workshops in California, traveled and painted throughout the United States and Canada, and has led painting trips to Spain, Holland, Britain, Middle Europe and Russia.

He is an award-winning artist in both the National Watercolor Society and Watercolor West, and is a signature member in both organizations. Chris has served several years on the board of the National Watercolor Society, and as president for the past three years.

He has mounted six one-man shows. Chris has juried many shows including the Nevada Watercolor Society, the South Bay Watercolor Society, San Gabriel Fine Arts, Watercolor West and the Arizona Watercolor Association. He has taught Yosemite and Sequoia workshops for the past 25 years. Chris was selected as one of the "top twenty" art instructors by Watercolor Magazine.

AL SETTON ACRYLICS WORKSHOP JANUARY 21 – 23, 2009

An Al Setton Workshop creates an opportunity for discovery. Content of this three day workshop will center around design/composition and expressive use of color. along the way, Al will identify and discuss ways to address common painting problems he has encountered in his years of teaching, attending shows, and judging exhibits. His artistic journey is self-directed beginning with training at California Art Institute. Since then he has selectively attended workshops and seminars of many prominent artists as well as doing extensive study and "eye training" by attending museums and art shows.

Al's large format paintings have energetic relationships of shapes and color harmonies. To help you get the most from this workshop, he suggests giving some thought ahead of time to what you would like to get out of it. Paint looser? Better design? Better color? How to add emotional content? None of the above? During the workshop, you will have opportunity for instruction tailored to your needs, especially if you know what you would like to achieve.

Al will be demonstrating in acrylics. However, you may use any medium you wish unless it is too smelly or too dusty that it may bother others. He creates a casual, friendly atmosphere and an easy, open dialogue with students, making his workshops a joyful experience. THERE IS STILL SPACE IN THIS WORKSHOP!!!

Mid-Valley Arts League is sponsoring a JoAnn Formia workshop this fall. During the workshop JoAnn will emphasize using a sketch as the basis for painting. She will teach the importance of working from a second or third generation sketch for the design and value of a completed work. In this way, the painter eliminates a lot of detail –creating a painting based on larger shapes to which details can be added at the end. JoAnn will also cover negative painting and the use of dark values which make a painting readable. A favorite quote she recently discovered is, "Creativity is allowing yourself to make mistakes. Art is knowing which ones to keep." In her enthusiastic teaching style, she will take us through the steps for choosing "which ones to keep."
