KATE McDANIEL & LYNNE FEARMAN

Kate McDaniel was born and raised in Glendale, California, but later in life spent 17 years in Maryland before returning to California in 2002. She completed her education at the University of Maryland with a Bachelor's degree in Studio Art and went on to get a Bachelors and Masters in Art Education and taught Art in Middle and High School in Maryland for 9 years.

Upon returning to California, she began exploring watercolor. She enjoys studio and plein-air painting as well as painting still life with a contemporary flare, flowers, and negative painting. She likes the challenge of watercolor painting to create a visual mood on paper that evokes a memory, a feeling, or a moment in time. Other interests are collage, gouache, and gel printing!

She has been on the Board of Mid Valley Arts League for several years, and has won several awards in their exhibits. Her paintings have been selected for Watercolor West the past two years.

Lynne Fearman is an active member of Mid-Valley Arts League, (president from 2006-2008), artist member of California Art Club, Oil Painters of America, and American Impressionist Society.

Fearman was invited to create, "Bearlovian Paradise", a permanent art installation for the Monrovia Library in 2010. In 2015 she received the Grand Prize for the Los Angeles Plein Air Festival, which led to her invitation to participate in the Washington Plein Air Festival, "Paint the Peninsula!" in 2016. In 2018 & 2019 OPA awarded her the "Award of Excellence" in the National Show during the Wet Paint Competition. She won the "Gold Medal" at California Art League's Gold Medal Show in 2017. Lynne is the location master for the Thursdays en Plein Air Group that meets to paint every week.

Lynne will be demonstrating how to rough in a background and continue to a completed landscape in oils. All to be finished in an hour and a half.

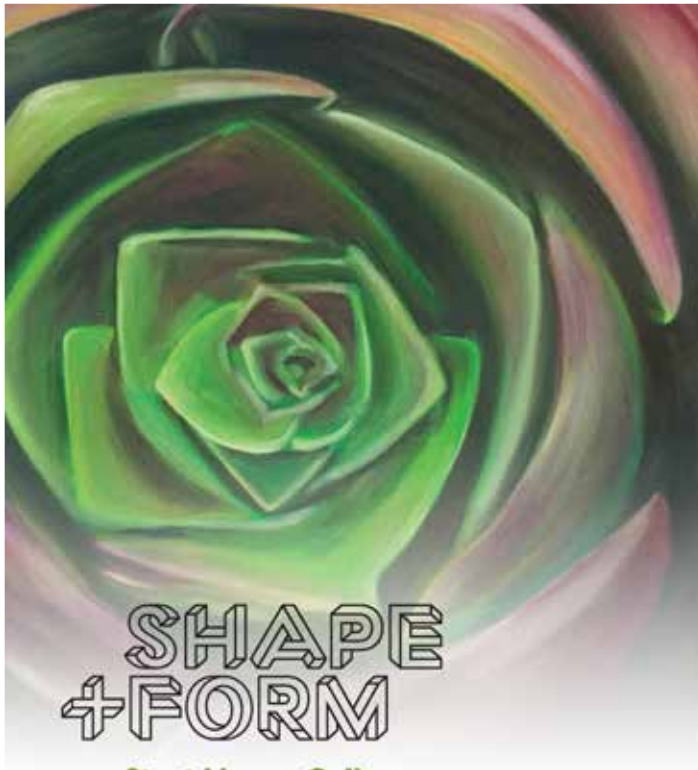

ZOOM WORKSHOP

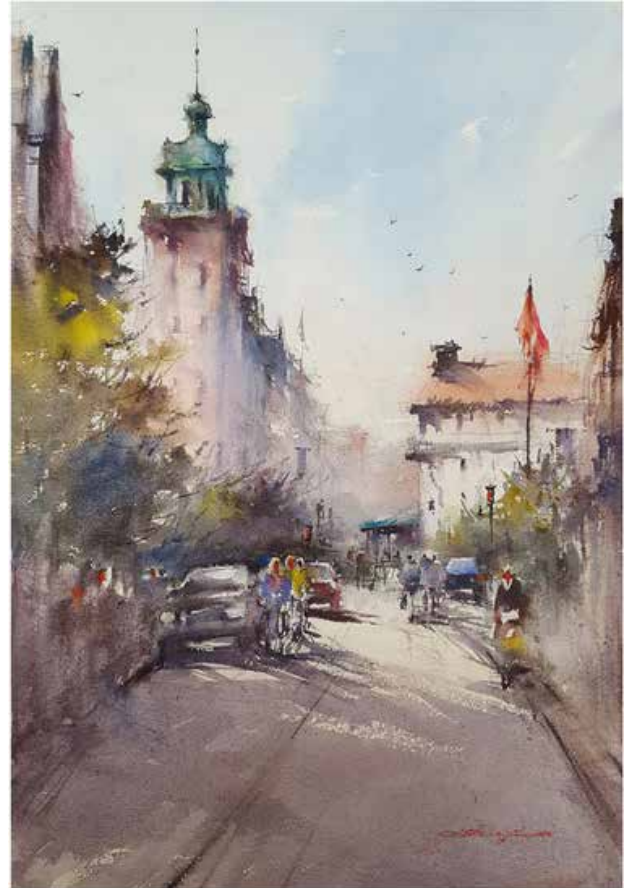
SHUANG LI

Born, raised and classically trained in China, Shuang Li received her BA Degree in Graphic Design and Master's Degree in Art History. After moving to the United States, Shuang Li received her MFA (Master of Fine Art) Degree from The Department of Art, University of Oregon, in 1991.

Following the traditional "En Plein Air" Impressionism approach, Shuang paints watercolor both on location and in her studio. She portrays the extraordinary variety of life with her unique perspective. With masterful classic and contemporary techniques, Shuang recreates nature's beauty in her paintings by capturing moods and moments of light and color. She is noted for her singular poetic expression.

A signature member of the National Watercolor Society, American Impressionist Society, American Society of Marine Artists, Laguna Plein Air Painters Association, San Diego Watercolor Society, and Watercolor West, and an Elected Artist Member of California Art Club,

Shuang Li's watercolor paintings have long been favored by collectors. She has also exhibited in national and international galleries and group shows and has earned many honorable awards. With her extensive teaching background, Shuang has been regularly invited by art organizations for her popular plein air painting demonstrations, art workshops, and classes. She also frequently serves as an invited juror for art competitions and art exhibitions.
